COVID Protocols

For NFL Personnel

All NFL personnel attending the 2022 East-West Shrine Bowl are required to be fully vaccinated to attend and work at the 2022 Shrine Bowl. NFL personnel may be asked at any time to show their vaccination card and verification during the event. Any unvaccinated NFL personnel that wish to attend the Shrine Bowl should contact Eric Galko prior to attending.

All NFL personnel are asked to take every precaution at the Shrine Bowl to limit their potential interaction with COVID, including wearing masks when in public settings and limiting close contact exposure during and outside of Shrine Bowl functions.

Testing locations will be provided to NFL personnel if they would like to get tested upon arrival, during the week, or prior to departure.

For Shrine Bowl Players

All players submit their COVID vaccinations status to the East-West Shrine Bowl, with proper COVID verification, prior to arrival.

All vaccinated players will not be required to wear masks during the week of the Shrine Bowl. Players will only be tested should they be symptomatic during their stay. All unvaccinated players will be required to wear a mask during all meetings, between meals, and at any time not on the practice or game field.

If any player is symptomatic, the Shrine Bowl will procure a private hotel room for these players as well as allow for these players to receive a COVID test. Any players who feel they were close contacts with a positive-tested player and would like to be tested for COVID will be able to do so.

Weigh In Procedures

This year, the East-West Shrine Bowl will not be having a formal weigh-in event as has been customary in previous years. Instead, players will be weighed and measured as a part of their check-in process on Thursday, January 27th. Weigh-ins will be conducted by National Football Scouting and NFS personnel.

Prior to being weighed in, every player will take a front and side-profile picture. Those player profiles as well as the official weigh-in results will be sent to every NFL personnel by Thursday, January 27th evening.

Cluster Interview Process

January 28 – January 30





The East-West Shrine Bowl Cluster Interview Process aims to provide every NFL team with ample access and time to speak with every player on the roster from Friday, January 28th to Sunday, January 30th. Exact times for each day are included in the Game Week Schedule.

NFL personnel will be divided among eight rooms, with four teams per room, in the Egyptian Ballroom at the Luxor Hotel (as seen in **Figure 1** below). Each room is at least 1200 square feet. Room assignments will be Each room is set up is as shown in **Figure 2**, with each team allocated space in the corner. NFL personnel may bring anything that would like into the room for interviews.

Players are grouped into five clusters per team (for a total of ten total clusters), approximately 12-13 players per cluster. Each cluster will be in their room for 55 minutes. Teams may interview players in conjunction with each other and/or speak with players privately. Center tables will also be provided for players to rest or be interviewed in tandem with other teams.

Each cluster will have a Shrine Bowl personnel assistant to assist you and the players. We expect cooperation from each team in communicating with other scouts to be respectful of both the player's time as well as your peers.

There is ten total hours assigned for Cluster Interviews between January 28th and January 30th, allowing for each team to meet with each cluster, and therefore every player, for an hour over the course of the weekend.

Formal Interview Process

January 31 – February 1

The East-West Shrine Bowl Formal Interview Process aims to provide NFL personnel with the opportunity to speak with players in a structured, formal environment. While it does not rise to the level of confidentiality





and spacing of the NFL Combine, we hope it can serve a similar purpose for the players on the Shrine Bowl rosters.

NFL personnel may submit formal interview request through a form sent out to the team's point of contact on Thursday, January 27th until Saturday, January 29th at 8pm PT. Formal requests are only seen by Shrine Bowl directors, and all requests and names are confidential. Teams may submit up to 24 names for request for 16 total available interview times.

NFL personnel will be divided among eight rooms, with at most four teams per room, in the Egyptian Ballroom at the Luxor Hotel (as seen in **Figure 1** below). Each room is at least 1200 square feet. These rooms include ample space for private discussion, and interview lists will not be displayed to any team. Layouts of rooms for Formal Interviews, shown in in **Figure 3**, are different to better support a more formal discussion.

Room assignments will be different than those used in the Cluster Interviews. NFL personnel may bring anything that would like into the room for interviews. NFL personnel will receive their room for formal interviews on Sunday, January 30th.

Each formal interview will be 25 minutes in length, for a total of 16 interviews across Monday, January 31st and Tuesday, February 1st.
